5 Day Devotional

Day 1: Meeting Us Where We Are

Devotional

Have you ever felt like your doubts and questions make you a 'bad' believer? Many of us have experienced moments where our faith feels shaky, and we wonder if God disapproves of our uncertainty. But the story of Thomas shows us something beautiful about God's character. Rather than condemning Thomas for his doubts, Jesus met him exactly where he was, offering precisely what Thomas needed to believe. This reveals a profound truth about God's love for us - He's not put off by our questions or uncertainties. Instead, He draws near to us in those very moments, ready to meet our deepest needs with patience and understanding.

Bible Verse

'Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe.'" - John 20:27

Reflection Question

What areas of your life do you need Jesus to meet you in right now? What would it look like to bring those needs honestly before Him?

Quote

Jesus loved Thomas enough that he was willing to meet Thomas where he was. And he loves you and me enough that he is willing to meet us exactly where we are today.

Prayer

Lord, thank you for meeting me exactly where I am. Help me to trust that You welcome my honest questions and doubts. Give me the courage to bring everything before You, knowing that Your love for me never wavers. Amen.

Day 2: The Courage to Question

Devotional

Sometimes we view doubt as a spiritual failure, but Thomas's story paints a different picture. Before his famous moment of doubt, Thomas showed incredible courage. He was willing to follow Jesus into danger, demonstrating that doubt and dedication can coexist. His later questioning didn't erase his earlier faithfulness - instead, it became part of his journey toward deeper faith. This reminds us that authentic faith isn't about having all the answers, but about being honest with God even in our uncertainty.

Bible Verse

'Then Thomas (also known as Didymus) said to the rest of the disciples, "Let us also go, that we may die with him.'" - John 11:16

Reflection Question

When have your doubts actually led to stronger faith? How might your current questions be invitations to grow closer to God?

Quote

Thomas, ever the straight-shooting realist, says, 'No way, guys. You're imagining things. To see his hands and feet might be good enough for all of you, but for me, I've actually got to touch him in those places in order for me to believe.'

Prayer

Father, give me the courage to be honest about my doubts. Help me see them not as failures, but as opportunities to know You more deeply. Thank You for being patient with my questions. Amen.

Day 3: Finding Direction in Doubt

Devotional

Life's path isn't always clear. Like Thomas, we often find ourselves wanting clear directions, seeking concrete answers to our questions about faith and life. We might look for a spiritual GPS - a set of precise instructions that will guarantee we're heading the right way. But Jesus offers something better than a mere roadmap. He offers Himself as our guide, inviting us into a relationship where He walks alongside us through every twist and turn of life's journey.

Bible Verse

"Thomas said to him, 'Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?' Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life.'" - John 14:5-6

Reflection Question

In what ways might you be seeking a 'spiritual GPS' rather than pursuing a relationship with Jesus? What might change if you focused more on knowing Him than knowing the way?

Quote

Have we ever looked for a set of directions, a list of do's and don'ts by which we may order our lives and be assured of a place in God's favor?

Prayer

Jesus, help me to trust You as my guide. When I'm tempted to just want answers, remind me that You offer something better - Yourself. Thank You for being my way, truth, and life. Amen.

Day 4: The Gift of Holy Uncertainty

Devotional

Sometimes God feels distant or silent, and our natural response might be to pull away or question His presence. But what if these moments of uncertainty are actually divine

invitations? Like Thomas, whose doubt led to one of the most intimate encounters with the risen Christ, our moments of questioning might be opportunities for deeper connection with God. When we feel far from God, it might be His gentle way of drawing us closer, inviting us to seek Him more earnestly.

Bible Verse

"Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you.'" - John 20:21

Reflection Question

Can you recall a time when feeling distant from God actually led to greater intimacy with Him? What might God be inviting you into through your current uncertainties?

Quote

When God seems far away or even silent, maybe that is A movement of the Holy Spirit urging us to come closer.

Prayer

Holy Spirit, help me recognize Your invitations even in moments of uncertainty. Thank You for using my doubts to draw me closer. Give me courage to respond to Your gentle nudges. Amen.

Day 5: The Journey Together

Devotional

Life's journey includes both mountain peaks and valley lows. Like Thomas and the other disciples, we may face moments of confusion, doubt, and worry about what lies ahead. But Jesus doesn't just give us a destination - He offers to walk with us through every step of the journey. He knows our needs, understands our fears, and promises to be with us through it all. This journey of faith isn't about having perfect understanding, but about growing in relationship with the One who perfectly understands us.

Bible Verse

"Peace be with you! After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord." - John 20:19-20

Reflection Question

How might your perspective change if you viewed your faith journey less as a solo trek and more as a walk with Jesus? What would it mean to truly share both your joys and sorrows with Him?

Quote

Jesus replies, 'Come know me. Together we will travel this life with its joys and sorrows, its ups and downs, the pain of the cross and the glory of resurrection.'

Prayer
