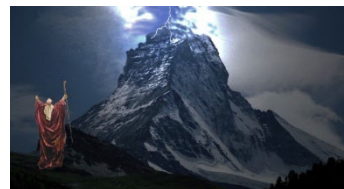

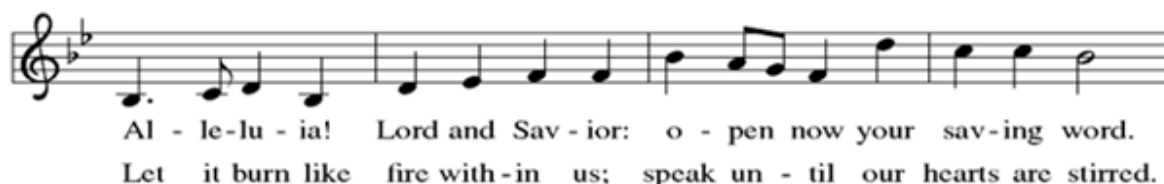

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

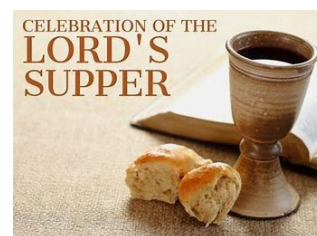
And we continue to give you thanks, Father, through Jesus the Christ,

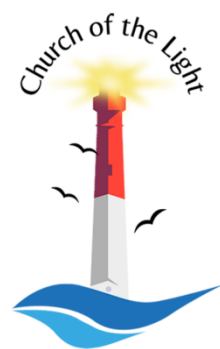
